EDITOR'S EDGE

Dear Sears Family:

Yes, we have a new address again. I have set up the post office box in attempts to stay in better touch with the world since we seem to change street addresses regularly. Mail is still delivered to the house if you prefer, and guests are welcome at 1301 Highland Way, Duncan, OK 73533.

The acquisition of the year is now in the hands of the association. George Weiss contacted me a few months ago to see if we wanted Samuel P May's personal copy of the Sears Genealogy. It's in pretty rough shape but is a valuable addition to our collection. I now have two copies of the original. Here is Samuel May's original letter offering subscriptions to the book.

**To the Descendants of Richard Sares [Sears] of Yarmouth, Mass.,
Wheresoever dispersed.**

Greeting:

The SEARS GENEALOGY, upon which I have been engaged for several years, is now ready for the printer, and will be printed as soon as sufficient subscriptions are received to warrant the outlay.

It will contain notices of over 4000 of the name, lineally descended from Richard Sares, who settled in Yarmouth, Mass., in 1639, with many descendants in female lines, some to the third generation,-- and in an appendix, notices of many other families of Sears that came early to this country.

It is expected to make over 500 pages octavo, will be fully indexed, and well printed and bound. The price to subscribers will be \$5.00, or \$5.25 if by mail.

The price is estimated to barely cover the cost of publication, my labor during several years in collecting and arranging material, and expenses incurred in procuring searches and copies of records, etc., being given gratuitously, and the work is published at my sole risk and cost.

The edition will be closely limited to subscribers, and will not be reprinted; it will therefore always be scarce, and persons desiring copies will do well to send their orders at once.

Every head of a family of Sears should possess a copy, to be transmitted from father to son; and where possible should procure one for each of their children, as another opportunity is not likely to occur during the present generation.

Well inflation has caught up with us as it cost nearly \$50 to print the books the second time around. We now have catalogued 20,785 Sears descendants to fifteen generations. The sixteenth generation will have to wait til the next millenium. Over 6,000 of these descendants have the surname Sears. We've much more data to catalogue and the searching will never end. The PAF database has grown to 36,625 people when we add in all the other Sears families and connections which have not been made. Many duplicates also

exist which must be carefully gleaned and combined with existing records to prevent accidental pruning of the tree.

The internet continues to be a wealth of information and I have not had much time to mine the data. I hope it does not disappear before I can record it. Many items which were there only a year ago, are already gone. Enjoy the SEARCH column. It is interesting to see the connection between Barnas Sears and Mr Roget, the thesaurus guy.

Since the books are all sold I have had a number of inquiries from people still wanting to buy a copy. If anyone has an extra Sears Genealogical Catalogue, let me know and I will put you in touch with a potential buyer.
