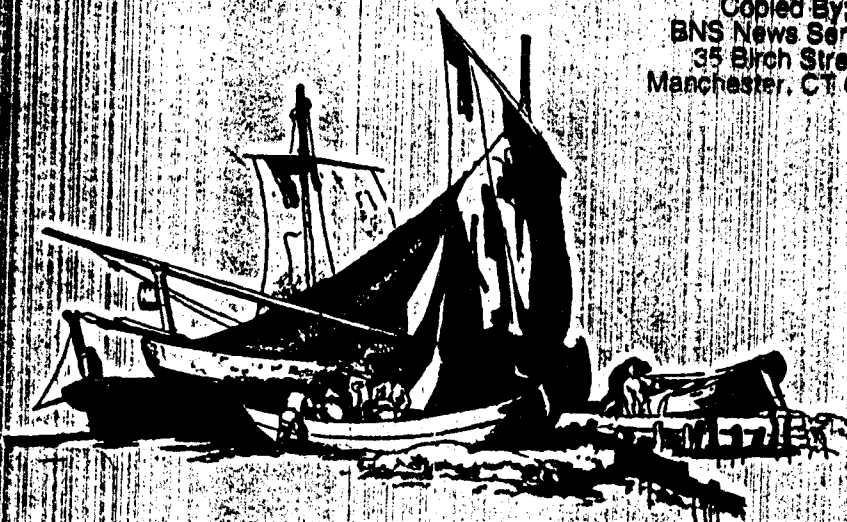

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SHANK. Fellow bondsman John COLVILL, both merchants of Saint John.

SEARING, James

City of Saint John, St. John Co., Mariner. Will dated 23 September 1799, proved 9 December 1799.

Brother Rowland SEARING, farmer, of Long Island in the State of New York, entire estate. Daniel McKEY, tailor, and Samuel LOCKARD (appears as "LOCKWOOD" in Record Book 'A', page 125), publican, of Saint John executors. Witnesses: Samuel SPEARS, William T. STOCKTON (Master of the Brig "Susannah" belonging to the port of Saint John), William KER.

SEARS, James 6427

No residence cited, St. John Co., Printer. Will dated 13 July 1825, proved 28 July 1825.

To sister Elizabeth 10 pounds. Sister Sarah all my books. Brother George my watch and chain, portrait and writing desk. To brothers George SEARS and William Charles SEARS residue of estate. Brothers George and William Charles SEARS executors. Witnesses: James CONDLE, James ALEXANDER, Samuel HALLETT.

SEARS, Thatcher 4214

City of Saint John, St. John Co. Intestate. Administration granted 11 August 1819 to Abigail SEARS, widow, William SEARS, George SEARS and William George CODY. Fellow bondsmen Samuel MILES and Henry GARDNER, all of the City of Saint John.

SEELY, Seth

Parish of Kingston, Kings Co., Yeoman. Will dated 28 December 1823, proved 8 May 1824.

Reserve four rods square of land for a burial ground on the hill on the east side of the highway to the Church Rector, Wardens and Vestry. Son Seth SEELY 100 acres of land on the west side of Kennebecasis River purchased of the Estate of Alexander FAIRCHILD. Son [Jorum] SEELY half of the hundred acres I bought of Isaac PERKINS. Son [Jerume] SEELY 100 acres on the west side of the Kennebecasis River in the Parish of Norton on the "Iland of Wood or Beach Iland" and the other part of the farm I give to my son Linus SEELY, being 200 acres.

Grandson Linus SEELY the north half of Lot 15. Grandson Seth SEELY, son of Linus SEELY land. Grand children Elias and Francis, children of my son William SEELY land. Grandson William [HALLAM] in New York 5 shillings. Movables to be divided among my daughters Tamar [BRATHNE], Sary EVANS and my great grand daughter Ann FREEMAN. Hanford BOSTWICK and David Pickett JAMES executors. Witnesses: Hamlin BRADLEY, William Berkeley BABB, Joseph A. LYON.

Inventory, dated 11 May 1824 at Long Reach, valued at 703 pounds by Richard WHELPLEY, Benjamin B. CRAWFORD and Joseph A. LYON.
