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EDITOR'S EDGE

Dear Sears Family:

Merry Christmas! What a wonderful time of year for family traditions and celebration. All of the Sears Genealogical Catalogue books have been sold so we are making plans for our next step. It will surely involve a CD-ROM for those of you who are computer buffs. For the rest we may look into some specialty publishing of smaller extracts from the database which are tailored to your particular branch of the family.

A short but wonderful trip to Boston and Cape Cod this summer brought the realization that three days in each place can only begin to scratch the surface of the wealth of information available there. The Boston Athenaeum allowed access to their manuscript research facilities to peruse papers from the Margaret Urann Collection (Capt Isaac Henry Sears 1833-1900 son of Isaac No 1867). More will be forthcoming here from that source. John Winthrop Sears, one our family's illustrious chroniclers, was very gracious to treat this researcher to a taste of Boston hospitality. You will see John W Sears archive as the source for much valuable information about our family history. The New England Historic Genealogical Society was a treat as always.

The Cape visit and warm welcome from the Dennis Historical Society was a highlight. The Ancient Sears Cemetery is in the best possible condition (considering it is 250 years old) due in great part to all the care provided by nearby Brewster resident Dick Tonis. We should consider pursuing registration of the cemetery as a National Historic Monument. It is interesting that the earliest stones (Jan 1724) are for children, there is a gap in dates til 1733 (another child) and then the use of the cemetery increases. There are some curious natural stones in the cemetery. Do you supposed it was used by the family before the 1720s. Estimates are that only 5% of early deaths were marked by carved gravestones. Maybe field stones were used before that time. In *Epitaph and Icon*, by George and Nelson, they only found eight stones on the Cape dated in the 1600s.

Finally we are transcribing records from the William L Clements Library, The University of Michigan, Ann Arbor which are all about Capt Peter Sears (1743-1802 No 615)and his family in Revolutionary War times. These papers must have come down from Solomon Fuller Sears, of Ann Arbor (1816- No 3284) as S.P. May mentions these papers in his book.

Urbane is an unusual name but it is clearly spelled Urbane in a number of official records and by family members. He was presumably named after Rev Urbane Hitchcock who served in West Hawley around the time of his birth.

25 Mar 1892 - Know all men by these presents That I, Tryphosa Sears of Hawley in the county of Franklin and state of Massachusetts widow of the late Urbane Sears of said Hawley, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament.

First, I give and bequeath to my daughters Martha T Vincent, Ella C Temple and Clara B Childs fifty dollars Each.

Second, I give and bequeath to my son George W Sears all the rest and residue of my Estate both real and personal after paying the above named legacies.

Third I ordain and appoint my son George W Sears of said Hawley to be the Executor of my Will and request that he be not required to give bonds with surety or sureties, his personal bond being deemed sufficient.

In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal and in the presence of three witnesses declare this to be my last Will this twenty fifth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety two.

(signed) Tryphosa Sears

On this 25th day of March A.D. 1892 Tryphosa Sears signed the foregoing instrument in our presence declaring it to be her last will and testament and as witnesses thereto we three do now at her request in her presence and in the presence of each other hereto subscribe our names.

She was 90 years old. Surviving are two sons, John C of Yarmouth Port and Prof Theodore C Boyden of Atlanta; a daughter, Elizabeth, and two grandchildren. Mrs Boyden was recognized as a great teacher in her own right. Together she and her husband served the school for more than half a century, during which the obscure village academy became one of the nation's leading preparatory schools for boys. The daughter of an old Deerfield farm family, Helen Childs was born Sept 20, 1883. After graduating in 1904 from Smith College in nearby Northampton, she taught school briefly in Stamford, Conn. In 1905, Deerfield Academy needed a teacher, and she applied for the job. Frank L Boyden, who had been principal of the school since his graduation from Amherst in 1902, was not at all enthusiastic about the young applicant. But the school was too poor to insist on someone more experienced. He hired her on a temporary basis. They were married two years later. Mrs Boyden dropped out of teaching at that time. But in 1913 she returned to the classroom. In a highly personal style she cajoled thousands of students through the intricacies of mathematics and chemistry. Even in a large class she taught the individual, not the group. Her tongue was quick, but never cutting. One boy, later a college president, recalls her telling him: "Victor! When will you stop trying to remember and start trying to think?" Mrs Boyden gave confidence to the slower students, prodded the able ones to do better and gave the process of learning an exciting, dramatic quality. As Deerfield changed from a small village day school to a boarding school and its reputation spread, honors came to Mrs Boyden as well as her husband. Smith made her an honorary Doctor of Humane Letters at her 25th reunion in 1939. Trinity College did the same in 1952. In 1946, St Lawrence University made Mrs Boyden an honorary Doctor of Science. Like her husband, Mrs Boyden knew each boy personally. If, unlike him, she could not recognize each one at first glance after a lapse of years, they knew it was because of the shortsightedness she always joked about. I am quite sure he had no idea his ancestors were pioneers in settling many towns on the Cape. His hobbies were jazz (he used to sing and play bass in a traveling band during the early 1940's), restoring antique automobiles (1928 Model A, 4 door that we bought in NH for \$50) the building of a 50' sailboat, and buying Heath electronics kits (hi-fi stereo equipment) which he assembled at home. Humor and compassion were two of his dominant personality traits. He died as a result of a heart attack from a cancer operation on his lung. He is buried in Lake View Cemetery, Holliston (the town where he was born), MA.

BIOGRAPHY: I was born in Worcester at Memorial hospital. My hobbies were old cars and baseball both of which were pursued with single-mindedness and joy. My first car was a 1937 Chevrolet purchased from my neighbor Jimmy Rose for \$10 when I was 12 years old. I drove it all around the property, often without brakes, at breakneck speeds. The following year I moved up to a 1938 Chevrolet given to me by a retired neighbor up the street. I towed it home, started it up and spewed a whole family of mice living in the muffler all over the yard. One day my Dad came home to find that I had taken a can of barn red house paint to paint the car - under a cherry tree that dropped fruit into the paint before it dried. My other hobby was baseball. As a member of the Northboro Little League Tigers, I pitched the first no-hitter in the league history and was the leader in home runs for my final year. I played all the positions and loved every minute. My Dad coached the team one year and was also the league president. Both interests stayed with me for the rest of my life. I got fairly good grades at Algonquin Regional High School but did even better in college. My Dad pushed me to go, even filling out the application that he asked me to sign, when I had very little interest in doing so. Arizona State University was chosen because my mother's sister, Phoebe Shonerd and her husband David lived in Scottsdale close to the university. The fact that I detested New England winters made the decision all the easier. At the school I blossomed as an intellectual and an individual while having one of the best times of my life. Not only did I develop a lifelong love of learning and reading books, but out of it eventually evolved my career as a college professor. I graduated in 1966 With Distinction with a B.A. in Political Science and went on to graduate school at the University of California at Berkeley for a Masters Degree in Public Administration to become a city manager. This choice of degree was the direct result of my internship for the City of Tempe (1964-66) during my junior and senior years at ASU. In December 1966 I married Nancy Hagedorn whom I had met at ASU. My academic career was cut short when the Army drafted me in April 1967. None of the other services would take me because of my poor eyesight. The Army first classified me as a noncombatant but because of Vietnam later reclassified me as infantry. My basic training was at Ft Dix, NJ followed by Advanced Infantry Training at Ft McClellan, A. I signed up for Officer Candidate School at Ft Benning, GA and actually attended for three days but was allowed to quit because of an administrative recruiting error. The issue was referred to Robert McNamara, Secretary of Defense who decided we all had to sign the papers over again. Never enthused about Army life to begin with and knowing I was headed for Vietnam, I chose to reenlist as a noncommissioned officer and spend only 2 rather than 3 years in the

Army. To my surprise they sent me to Drill Sergeant's School at Ft Jackson, SC and I remained there as a drill instructor on Tank Hill (D-3-1) until I was given an early out (I served 22 months and was promoted to E-5 grade) to reenter graduate school - this time at the University of Hawaii in Honolulu in the American Studies department. I chose Hawaii for adventure, because of the warm weather, cheap out of state tuition and because of the interest I had in the American Studies program. I received my M.A. in American Studies and went on for my Ph.D. in American History. My dissertation advisor was Professor Walter Johnson, formerly of the University of Chicago, who was editing The Papers of Adlai E Stevenson at the University of Hawaii. Walter engineered the 1952 draft of Adlai Stevenson for the presidency. As his graduate student/assistant I became the Editorial Assistant for 4 of the 8 volumes. Walter also got me an internship with Adlai E Stevenson III, who at the time was a Senator from IL. While in Washington during the summer of 1972 I went swimming at the Watergate complex during the week of the famous burglary that brought down the Nixon administration. I also interviewed Senator William Fulbright (Walter had helped him set up the Fulbright Teacher Exchange Program) on the day he fed some of the Pentagon Papers to the editors of the New York Times. I received my doctorate in 1976 and worked piecemeal at several colleges until my full time job as Professor of American Studies and History at Kapiolani Community College, Honolulu, HI. I fell in love with the job, went on to become Social Science Department Chair (1985-1989) and was awarded the Excellence in Teaching Award in 1984. I was divorced in 1981 and remarried again in 1983 to Dorothy Mae Benevente of Chamorro/Spanish descent from Dedaod, Guam. We lived at 51-422 Lihumanu St in Kaaawa with her step-daughter Grace San Nicolas and, occasionally, my children would visit from Chandler AZ. Hobbies today include traveling, especially to historical places in the US, eating at historical inns, reading, restoring antique cars (I have owned a 1938 Chevrolet coupe, 1957 Chevrolet and presently own a 1974 T-bird and a 1968 Mustang convertible), genealogical research, cooking, flower gardening and home repairs of all sorts. I am 5'8" about 150 pounds with poor eyesight. In 1992 I was diagnosed with multiple myeloma. I had two children with my first wife and none with the second.
