

Introduction

The following pages list data for all known family members as of 8th December 2020.

Each immediate family is presented in their own section that contains a graphical family tree as well as a description with information about each referenced person and their children. The child section provides information about the children of the preceding couple. When a child has offspring of their own this is presented in a separate family section for that child. In this case a '+' is used to denote that an individual will appear later in the book as a parent with his/her own children and there is a link to the appropriate family reference number. For children with partners but no offspring the partner data is given with the reference family. Roman numerals, followed by a period, are used to indicate the birth order.

In the chapter titled "Families of the Starting Person" the ancestors of Josiah Sears are presented in a kind of enhanced Pedigree Chart which displays the graphic representation of their direct-line ancestors and the children of the couple. This chapter contains information about the couple whose relatives are listed in the later chapters.

The chapter titled "Families of his Ancestors" provides details (as known as of the publication date) for the relatives of Josiah Sears. There is a chapter for each generation. Relatives are listed in the order of the nearness of their relationship.

Sources for the information provided are given in the footnotes.

This document reports the details of 356 individuals, of whom 178 are male and 171 are female. The sex of 7 individuals is unknown. Of the 167 individuals with recorded birth and death dates, the average lifespan was 60.67 years. Of these, 87 males averaged 59.72 years, and 80 females averaged 61.69 years. The longest living male was Abner Sears (1738/39–1838), who died aged 98. The longest living female was Ruth Tilson (1765–1857), who died aged 92.

Adams, Sr. He lived for a while on Sherose Id. where he owned the Lincoln lot; but sold it and moved to Shag Hr. about 1792. Mr Sears was the ostensible informer against the absconding grantees whose titles were forfeited in 1784. In the Third division Josiah Sears, Sr. drew lot 89, laid off to Prince Freeman, near Brass Hill. (This Josiah lost both son Josiah and grandson Josiah on the Banks in the Schr. "J. P. Nickerson" a new vessel which they owned.)




Figure 1: History of Barrington Township 553




Figure 2: Sears Josiah 1751-1819 p11





Figure 3: Sears_Josiah_1751-1819_p12


Figure 5: sears_josiah&Crowell_Anna_marriage

There is the death of a Josiah Jan 1772- presumably the one born 1708. Then the marriage of Josiah (1708) and Azubah Knowles. Then the births of Marcy, Jerusha and then first Josiah Seers Son of Josiah Seers was born february the first 1744/5. I am still browsing the records at NEHGS- have not yet found the birth of the second Josiah- supposedly b. 1751 in Eastham. S P May says Josiah (1751) was a minor when his father's will was written in 1772. 72-51 = 21 ? Is not really a minor is he? I wonder if S P May confused this Josiah with the Josiah Sears father (1740-1770) and son (1767-1784) living in Halifax, Plymouth County, Mass. The first Josiah (1744) would not have been a minor. Maybe that's why he is listed as died young? The second Josiah seems to be the one who left for N.S. His younger brothers also left Eastham - i imagine Eastham was getting crowded-


Figure 7: Sears_Josiah_Azubah






Figure 11: Harding_Archelous




Figure 12: Massachusetts, Town and Vital Records, 1620-1988




Figure 13: Massachusetts, Town and Vital Records, 1620-1988








Figure 16: Connecticut Town Death Records, pre-1870 (Barbour Collection)




Figure 17: Connecticut, Hale Cemetery Inscriptions and Newspaper Notices, 1629-1934


Figure 18: The New England Historical & Genealogical Register, 1847-2011




Figure 22: bearse_benjamin





Figure 23: SPM69




Figure 26: SPM106AB




Figure 27: SPM106B





Figure 28: SPM107top




Figure 30: SPM106




Figure 31: SPM109





Figure 32: Massachusetts, Compiled Birth, Marriage, and Death Records, 1700-1850








Figure 33: Massachusetts, Town and Vital Records, 1620-1988








Figure 36: SPM189




Figure 37: SPM190





Figure 38: North America, Family Histories, 1500-2000


Figure 41: SPM191B




Figure 43: SPM108





Figure 47: Massachusetts, Town and Vital Records, 1620-1988






Figure 49: North America, Family Histories, 1500-2000




Figure 51: Rev Theodore Seth Harding Grave Stone




Figure 54: Swain-New Englanders in Nova Scotia Newspaper (Crowell/NEHGS)



Figure 55: Massachusetts, Death Records, 1841-1915







Figure 57: Connecticut, Hale Cemetery Inscriptions and Newspaper Notices, 1629-1934





Figure 58: 1881 Census of Canada
