

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Introduction

The following pages list data for all known family members as of 23rd November 2020.

Each immediate family is presented in their own section that contains a graphical family tree as well as a description with information about each referenced person and their children. The child section provides information about the children of the preceding couple. When a child has offspring of their own this is presented in a separate family section for that child. In this case a '+' is used to denote that an individual will appear later in the book as a parent with his/her own children and there is a link to the appropriate family reference number. For children with partners but no offspring the partner data is given with the reference family. Roman numerals, followed by a period, are used to indicate the birth order.

In the chapter titled "Family of the Starting Person" the ancestors of Roland Sears are presented in a kind of enhanced Pedigree Chart which displays the graphic representation of their direct-line ancestors and the children of the couple. This chapter contains information about the couple whose relatives are listed in the later chapters.


The chapter titled "Families of his Ancestors" provides details (as known as of the publication date) for the relatives of Roland Sears. There is a chapter for each generation. Relatives are listed in the order of the nearness of their relationship.

Sources for the information provided are given in the footnotes.

This document reports the details of 243 individuals, of whom 111 are male and 130 are female. The sex of 2 individuals is unknown. Of the 152 individuals with recorded birth and death dates, the average lifespan was 56.43 years. Of these, 70 males averaged 58.25 years, and 81 females averaged 54.66 years. The longest living male was Joseph Edmund Phelps (1805–1895), who died aged 90. The longest living female was Mehitable Haskell (1744–1845), who died aged 100.

Dea. Roland⁶ Sears (*Freeman*⁵, *Roland*⁴, Joseph³, Silas², Richard¹) was born on Friday, 24th December 1762, in Hardwick, Worcester, 1. Massachusetts, USA. [1, 2] He was the son of Freeman Sears (3) and Mehitable Haskell (4).



Roland died in Greenwich, Hampshire, on 22nd March 1851, at the age of 88.^[1, 2] He was buried in Ware.^[1]

!S P May p.299 A tall, erect figure, very kindly and benevolent to the poor, industrious, and with large executive ability, claiming that six hours' sleep was enough for any man. He had a sterling sense of honesty, and fair dealing. He was a patriot, and loved his country, enlisting in its service when but a mere lad of sixteen, and he often astonished his grand-children and friends with recitals of their privations and sufferings during the Roland Sears of Greenwich, Hamp. co., MA, 17 years, 5 feet, 8 inches in height dark complexion, arrived in Springfield, 18 Jul 1780, for service in northern army; he had previously served, 17-21 Aug 1777, in Capt Ephraim Jennings' Co., Col David Field's Regt. at Bennington, 30 miles; 12 Sep 1777 to 4 Jan 1778, in Capt Eben. Newell's Co., Col Key's regt; and 21 Jul to 25 Aug 1779, at New London, CT, in Capt Elisha Dwight's Co, Col Elisha Porter's Regt, 85 miles from home. In 1787 he took oath of allegiance, having been concerned in Shay's rebellion. His name appears in census of 1840, as a Revolutionary pensioner, then aged 77. "Dea Roland, as he was called, to distinguish him from his brothers, Dea Andrew and Dea John, who lived near by, was a very conscientious, religious man, quite after the Pilgrim type. He offered grace at every meal. With the greatest reverence I recall my grandfather on his knees in the family prayers, in his earnest and devout expressions of gratitude and thankfulness; and his confessions of shortcomings. And the closing words of the prayer have never left my childish memory, and I often find myself closing the petition with them: 'And now Lord, what wait we for? Our wants and complaints are spread before Thee, and Thou knowest what we need, better than we can think or even ask.' Many years ago, in a great movement in the Congregational Church, Dea Sears avowed himself a believer in one God, a Unitarian; quite a grief to his wife, a sweet Christian lady. Later on they both accepted the faith, that evil can never perpetuate itself, in the other life, and as the result every soul shall confess, and glorify God forever.

At the age of 22, Roland married **Mary Fletcher** on Tuesday, 29th November 1785, in 2. Barre, Worcester, when she was 18 years old. They had nine children.

Mary was born in Barre on Wednesday, 1st July 1767.[1] She reached 81 years of age and died in Greenwich, Hampshire, on 1st February 1849.[1] Mary was buried in Ware.[1]




Figure 1: SPM297




Figure 3: SPM299




Figure 2: SPM298




Figure 4: SPM300




Figure 5: Massachusetts, Death Records, 1841-1915






Figure 6: SPM184





Figure 8: SPM301



I was in between computers and got sidetracked by weddings of children and grandbabies being born. I looooove genealogy and I am a math teacher with obsessive compulsive tendencies so when I finally had time and bought my new laptop I subscribed again to Ancestry wanted to work on some brick walls of mine. I hit the mother load first on www.famiysearch.org <http://www.famiysearch.org> and found my GGG grandmother Satina Blackmer's christening record with her mother Millissent Blackmer. Then, I found two marriage records - the first Melicent Sears married to David Blackmer on 1 December 1785, and then her second to Rufus Field on 1 May 1816. I was so happy! And then I started researching the Sears line and Massachusetts had so many town records online! I had been looking for Satina's parents for 3 decades! This week I was on spring break and in between watching little granddaughters I found your website Descendants of Richard Sears. I love all the historical details and the way it is written with the numbers, little roman numerals and even M and F - it is great!

!I know it is hard to keep track of the female lineage so I wanted to give you the details on Millissent. Her name is spelled many ways and It is not easy finding her at times. On the 1850 census she was still living and was apart from her younger husband living with David Blackmer her son who was born about 1803, with her name being written as Michael Field(Sears) age 83. I found the christening information for not only Satina, but also Augustus and David Blackmer . After her death her son David moved to Michigan to Washtenaw County. GGG Grandmother Satina and husband Seth Flitcroft had moved to New York and then to Allegan County, Michigan about the same time 1856, I haven't been able to find Augustus yet. Well, I could go on and on..... Thank you for providing me with lots of reading material for weeks. I hope this email finds you well and still working on genealogy! !I wanted to ask you if you would help me out and look at your Sears database and specifically, the Blacknur/Blackmer/Blackmores and see if you have a source for 2073 through 2081 and their birthdates and if you have any further information about them. I'm really beginning to think my GGGG Grandmother Millissent Sears married the David Blackmer who was her 2nd cousin and is the son of Peter Blacknur/Blackmer, who was the son of Hannah Sears, who was the daughter of Joseph Sears. I have been reading everything I can find on the internet as far as the Blackmer genealogy and trying to


rule out different David Blackmers. On the 1790 Census for Greenwich there is David Blackmer (with Millissent), Roland Blackmer, and Peter Blackmer Jr., who would all be brothers, and then in 1800 they are joined by Amos and Moses who are also their brothers. David is gone in 1800, but when I looked at Freeman Sears in 1800 Greenwich and checked his census it looks like David and Millissent could be with him. David Blackmer then died soon after Satina was born according to her brother David's obituary. David Jr. and Satina both ended up moving to Michigan. David Jr. had Millissent with him on the 1850 census in Franklin Co, Ma before her death 6 March 1853 and then his family moved by 1860 to Michigan. Satina and her family moved to New York first for 30 years and then moved to Michigan by 1860. I am loving this new Sears line. I had pretty well given up on my Satina Blackmer's parents and had not really looked for a few years. A distant cousin had given me the wrong information for her parents listed on her death certificate (and actually she has it wrong on Find a Grave too) She thought "Wilson" Blackmer had to be the father, but when I went up to Michigan and looked at it with the county clerk she said no, this is the mother and it looks like "Milson" Blackmer, which is really Millisent Sears Blackmer. Her name is spelled wrong on every single result on Ancestry. But when you look at the image you can tell it is Millissent or Milicent. Her name was spelled correctly on Familysearch thank goodness because that is where I first found Millissent Sears and David Blackmer I thought you might want this information: Millissent Sears born as Satina's parents. to Freeman and Mehitable Sears on 20 September 1767 married first David Blackmer on 1 December 1785 Gill, Greenwich, Massachusetts. They had three known children: Augustus Blackmer (I can't find him anywhere), David Blackmer born 15 October 1803, and Satina Blackmer born 24 June 1806 all in Greenwich and baptized 1806. She married 2nd Rufus Field on 1 May 1816 in Greenwich. Rufus Field was born 23 November 1744 Northfield, Massachusetts and died 12 December 1820 Erving, Franklin Co, Massachusetts. 


Figure 12: SPM449D




Figure 13: Massachusetts, Town and Vital Records, 1620-1988




Figure 14: Massachusetts, Wills and Probate Records, 1635-1991




Figure 15: Massachusetts, Death Records, 1841-1915




Figure 16: Massachusetts, Marriage Records, 1840-1915





Figure 17: SPM105



camp at Dorchester Heights, 15 Feb 1776. He was elected Major of Col Holman's Regt., 26 Jun 1776, and served as Lt Col in the three months service, 12 Aug to 15 Nov 1781, 3 mos., 10 days' service, and 140 miles travel.




Figure 18: SPM185




Figure 19: SPM186





Figure 20: sears_barnabas_ofHardwick







Figure 21: SPM187






Figure 23: 1800 United States Federal Census





Figure 24: Massachusetts, Town and Vital Records, 1620-1988






Figure 26: SPM302





Figure 28: New York, State Census, 1855








Figure 29: Massachusetts, Town and Vital Records, 1620-1988




Figure 31: Rhode Island, Vital Extracts, 1636-1899





Figure 32: U.S., Newspaper Extractions from the Northeast, 1704-1930




Figure 33: SPM302





Figure 34: SPM303




Figure 35: Connecticut, Hale Cemetery Inscriptions and Newspaper Notices, 1629-1934




Figure 36: Massachusetts, Town and Vital Records, 1620-1988




Figure 37: U.S., Newspaper Extractions from the Northeast, 1704-1930





Figure 40: Massachusetts, Town and Vital Records, 1620-1988




Figure 44: Turner Sears death record





Figure 43: SPM451A




Figure 47: Massachusetts, State Census, 1855





Figure 48: Massachusetts, Town and Vital Records, 1620-1988





Figure 50: SPM451BNote





Figure 52: 1870 United States Federal Census




Figure 55: Massachusetts, Death Index, 1901-1980




Figure 56: 1880 United States Federal Census





Figure 59: Massachusetts, Death Records, 1841-1915





Figure 61: Connecticut, Hale Cemetery Inscriptions and Newspaper Notices, 1629-1934





Figure 63: 1880 United States Federal Census




Figure 66: 1880 United States Federal Census





Figure 67: Connecticut, Town Marriage Records, pre-1870 (Barbour Collection)
