

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Introduction

The following pages list data for all known family members as of 21st October 2020.

Each immediate family is presented in their own section that contains a graphical family tree as well as a description with information about each referenced person and their children. The child section provides information about the children of the preceding couple. When a child has offspring of their own this is presented in a separate family section for that child. In this case a '+' is used to denote that an individual will appear later in the book as a parent with his/her own children and there is a link to the appropriate family reference number. For children with partners but no offspring the partner data is given with the reference family. Roman numerals, followed by a period, are used to indicate the birth order.

In the chapter titled "Families of the Starting Person" the ancestors of Rufus Sears are presented in a kind of enhanced Pedigree Chart which displays the graphic representation of their direct-line ancestors and the children of the couple. This chapter contains information about the couple whose relatives are listed in the later chapters.

The chapter titled "Families of his Ancestors" provides details (as known as of the publication date) for the relatives of Rufus Sears. There is a chapter for each generation. Relatives are listed in the order of the nearness of their relationship.

Sources for the information provided are given in the footnotes.

This document reports the details of 192 individuals, of whom 91 are male and 100 are female. The sex of one individual is unknown. Of the 120 individuals with recorded birth and death dates, the average lifespan was 57.39 years. Of these, 61 males averaged 57.01 years, and 58 females averaged 58.75 years. The longest living male was Judge Enos Parsons (1815–1906), who died aged 91. The longest living female was Florence E Morse (1872–1966), who died aged 93.

Families of the Starting Person

Rufus Sears

1. Dea Rufus⁶ Sears (Nathaniel⁵, Samuel⁴, Josiah³, Silas², Richard¹) was born on Tuesday, 9th January 1770, in Yarmouth, Barnstable, Massachusetts, USA.^[1-3] He was the son of Nathaniel Sears (4) and Phebe Lincoln (5).

Rufus died in Hawley on 16th November 1856, at the age of 86.^[1, 2] He was buried in Hawley.^[1] https://www.wikitree.com/wiki/Sears-3184

!S.P. May p.315 Rufus Sears was born in the east precinct of Yarmouth, now Dennis, MA, in 1770, and was but a few weeks old when his father died. He lived with his mother until eleven years old, (who meanwhile had married Gorham Baker,) and then removed with his sister, Desire, wife of Dea. Joseph Bangs, to Hawley, then an almost unbroken wilderness, with a few scattering log-houses, and lived with her until 21. He then made a visit to his mother on Cape Cod, carrying his clothes and provisions in a pack, and traveling all the distance on foot; spent the winter with her, and in March, not wishing to go to sea, as the other young men were then doing, he shouldered his pack and trudged back to Hawley again. When he left the Cape the farmers were planting; arriving at Hawley, he found the land still covered with the last winter's snow. He then purchased and cleared a tract of land, put up a small house, and about 1793 married Priscilla Sears. He professed to be a follower of the meek and lowly Jesus before he was 21, endeavored to train up his children in the right way, and was a Deacon in the Congregational Church for many years.

!Hawley, Mass The First Fifty Years 1770-1820 by Harrison Parker p. 65 Despite the presence of a doctor [Daniel Fobes], townsfolk were still subject to many ailments for which there was no cure. The infant death rate was high. One particularly bad year was 1802, when scarlet fever and other diseases swept through the town. Eleven children under the age of 10, died that year alone. The worst hit family was that of Rufus Sears. His first wife and 3 youngest children died within three weeks of each other in November and December, 1802. He was left alone to care for the two surviving children, ages 7 and 8. The original layout of what later became Middle Road began opposite the Pudding Hollow School House. It angled between the present-day Rice and Rich properties to the Rufus Sears' farm (presently the home of Harrison Parker). A branch road ran down the hill northward from the Rufus Sears farm, ending at Zenas Bangs' home. The main east west road through Hawley ... continued eastward to Calvin Oaks' home and tavern (now Richard Sears' vacation home). District 1 grew from 141 in 1800 to 166 in 1820. The valuation of Rowland Sears and his sons totaled \$868. The house (located where Harold White, Jr. lives now) was worth \$150. It was situated on 32 acres of cleared land.

Once upon a time. in a simple home on the edge of Sesuet meadow. there was born a little boy named Rufus Sears. He was the sixth child and first son of Capt. Nathaniel Sears and his wife Phebe. How joyfully he must have been welcomed by his five older sisters and proud parents. He was christened in the old East Parish church by the Rev. Nathan Stone who had christened his sisters. It would seem that Rufus would live a contented life in the quiet Cape Cod village now called East Dennis. Probably he would follow his father to sea, and marry a girl from his neighborhood. But fate decreed otherwise. When he was but one and one half years old his father was lost at sea. Widow Sears must struggle to keep her family together, educating and providing for them as best she could. Perhaps she was unable to afford to send Rufus to school at the district schoolhouse, but she did make sure he learned to read. It is very likely that his reading primer was the Bible, a book with which he continued to read and study throughout his life. In due time. Widow Sears became the wife of Gorham Baker, and Rufus' sisters found husbands and set up their own homes. They married farmers at a time when farming was becoming less and less profitable on the Cape due to the depletion of top soil. And so it was that in 1781 a large group of young Cape families packed up all their belongings and emigrated lo Western Massachusetts. Rufus' sister, Phebe, who had married Deacon Joseph


Bangs. were among those emigrants, and Rufus, age 11, made the long journey to Hawley with them. It was a sad parting for these young pioneers. They were headed for a rugged wilderness and they knew that it was unlikely they would ever see home and family again. Tradition says they were accompanied to the town boundary by most of the residents of the two north side villages, and there were bidden a very sad good-by. However, the children of Phehe Sears Baker made the trip without any serious problems and soon were settled on their own homesteads raising sheep for wool and mutton. Rufus lived with the Bangs family, working around the farm to earn his keep and learning farm ways. As his early education had bent him when he was but a twig, so as a young man did the tree incline. He continued to he an avid student of the Bible. a staunch supporter of the Hawley Orthodox Church, which his brother-in-law served as Deacon. As he reached maturity his thoughts returned to the little seaside village where he had been born. He longed to see once more the mother at whose knee he had been taught. So, carrying his possessions on his back, he set off for East Dennis. It is not recorded how many days he walked, but walk he did--every step of the 216 miles from Hawley to Quivet Neck on Cape Cod. There he enjoyed a happy reunion with his beloved mother, her husband and his young step-brother. He spent the winter "at home hearing the sermons of Rev. Stone. and becoming reacquainted with the sounds of the sea and his sea-faring relatives. But after 10 years of living away Rufus was now more of a farmer than a mariner. He found no interest in following his father in a career at sea. So, as winter waned, Rufus prepared to leave his ancestral home, to return to his adopted homeland in Western Massachusetts. As he left Dennis the farmer / fishermen of Cape Cod were getting ready to plant before going a-fishing. When he arrived in Hawley snow was still on the ground. This was to be the only journey home that Rufus Sears would make. In Hawley, he married a distant cousin, named Priscilla Sears. Like him, she had been made an orphan by the sea, and, also like him, had travelled with family members to find a new, perhaps safer, life in the farmlands of Western Massachusetts. Rufus became a Deacon of the church, a farmer widely known as a pious, highly respected citizen of his adopted town. And in the autumn and winter of his life, until the day he died in 1856, I suspect that he delighted in retelling the story of his long walk home to East Dennis, then home to Hawley way back in 1791.



[1-3] They had six children: Rufus (1803–1882), Anthony (1805–1873), Priscilla (1807–1877), Maria (1809–1876), Frederick (1811–1894) and Benjamin (1814–1880).

Maria was born in Yarmouth, Barnstable, on Thursday, 6th July 1775.^[1, 2] She was the daughter of Anthony Howes and Martha Howes.





Seth was born in perh, Harwich, on 4th October 1751. He was the son of David Hall and Tamsen Sears.





Anthony Wing reached 67 years of age and died in Smithfield, Providence, Rhode Island, on 22nd October 1831.



Admiral Peary carried Collins tools to the North Pole. Typical of New England mills, the Collins Company axe factory was sited on a river and their production was powered by utilizing the water's strength to turn turbines and power machines. The numerous old buildings ramble along the riverbanks intertwined by an intricate maze of sluices that run throughout the site. The company closed its doors in 1966, but the factory buildings are now home to an eclectic and constantly changing mixture of tenants, including antique sellers, offices, artists' studios, woodworkers and a dance studio. Like a character in a Horatio Alger story, Edward Hale Sears (1846-1907) rose through the ranks of the Collins Company from fifteen year-old temporary employee to President. Even when elevated to the head of the company, he was visible in the shops and became not only the most powerful man in the village but, perhaps, the best loved as well.

Sears moved to Collinsville with his family in 1859 at age 13 when his father took a job as head of the company steel department. By the time he entered Collinsville High school, he was an earnest student, excellent in mathematics and with an artistic and mechanical bent. His chief recreation was designing and making toys for himself and his younger brothers. By twelve he had built a miniature locomotive of wood that ran on the steam supplied by his mother's teakettle.

At age 15, he took a short term job in the department where bayonets were made for the Union war effort. In 1862, at age 16, Sears had his trunk packed for Yale when he filled in for an ill bookkeeper. His work for the Collins Company was a temporary assignment that would last for the rest of his life. Within a year he became a draftsman, surveyor and shipping clerk. In 1886, at age 39, Sears was elected President of the company, a position he would hold until his death in 1907. Even with the cares of the company on his shoulders, Sears kept a good sense of humor and often praised his workmen. He was Canton's representative to the 1902 state constitutional convention.

Sears died of bronchial pneumonia just short of his 61st birthday. "One cannot adequately describe the depression and gloom that have been cast over this prosperous manufacturing village," lamented the Hartford Courant. Edward Hale Sears is buried in the Village Cemetery in Collinsville.
